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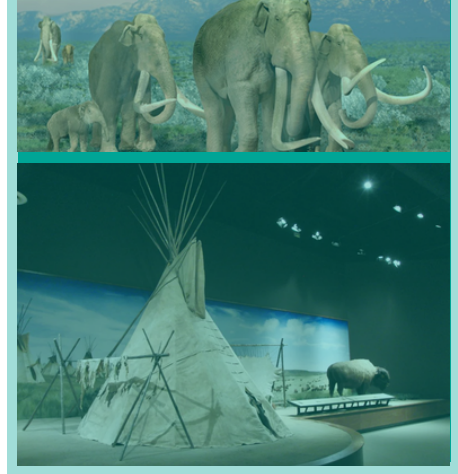


RECOMMENDED PROGRAMMING GRADES 3-5

3RD GRADE ICE AGE: TEXAS

TEXAS GEOLOGY, PALEONTOLOGY, & NATURAL SCIENCE

Participants visit the Waco Mammoth National Monument where students examine the remains of an entire nursery herd of mammoths and learn about the Ice Age in Texas. The group then travels to the Mayborn Museum where they delve into the Texas' natural history, wonders, and curiosities!



4TH GRADE TEXAS HISTORY & SCIENCE ALIVE

TEXAS HISTORY, GOVERNMENT & NATURAL SCIENCE

Participants tour the State Capitol of Texas and the Texas State Visitors Center in Austin before ending the day at Inner Space Cavern in Georgetown. The day is filled with learning about our state government and leaders, tales, and heroes at the Capitol and Visitors Center before taking a look underground to learn about the ancient history of this great state! Double the subjects, double the souvenirs, too!

5TH GRADE MAKING WAVES WITH WATER

TEXAS ECOLOGY, SUSTAINABILITY, SYSTEMS & CYCLES

Participants on the Making Waves With Water program learn about the ecology of a wetland and their role in the overall health of our ecosystem. They will collect and analyze macroinvertebrate data at the John Bunker Sands Wetlands Center, discover if they are a "Water Saver" or "Water Waster," and will learn the power of mimicking nature as they learn about vermicomposting and different naturally occurring cycles!



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
